- Reduce the global maternal mortality ratio to less than 70 per 100,000 live births
- End preventable deaths of newborns and children under 5 years
- End the epidemics of AIDS, tuberculosis and malaria



In 2020, the WHO African Region accounted for approximately 70 percent of global maternal deaths.



The region accounted for approximately 95 percent of malaria deaths globally, with children under five accounting for 78 percent of malaria deaths in Africa.
