

## **Transaid TCS London Marathon 2027**

### **Charity place Terms and Conditions**

These Terms and Conditions form the fundraising agreement between Transaid and participants who are allocated a Transaid charity place in the TCS London Marathon 2027.

By accepting a Transaid charity place, you agree to the following:

#### **1. Eligibility**

1.1 You confirm that you will be aged 18 or over on the day of the TCS London Marathon 2027.

1.2 You understand that allocation of a Transaid charity place is at the sole discretion of Transaid and that application does not guarantee a place.

#### **2. Registration**

2.1 If your application is successful, you must pay a non-refundable registration fee of £150 within 14 days of being offered a place.

2.2 The registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances, including injury, illness, pregnancy, change in personal circumstances, or withdrawal from the event.

2.3 The registration fee does not count towards your fundraising target.

2.4 You must complete all registration requirements requested by London Marathon Events by the deadlines specified. Failure to do so may result in the loss of your place.

#### **3. Fundraising commitment**

3.1 By accepting a Transaid charity place, you agree to raise a minimum of £2,800 (excluding Gift Aid) for Transaid.

3.2 All funds raised in connection with your participation in the event must be raised solely for Transaid.

3.3 You agree to make every reasonable effort to exceed the minimum fundraising target where possible.

3.4 You agree to establish and actively promote your fundraising page and to undertake regular fundraising activities throughout the campaign period.

#### **4. Fundraising milestones**

4.1 To demonstrate reasonable progress towards your fundraising target, you agree to achieve the following milestones:

- £700 by 31 December 2026
- £1,400 by 28 February 2027
- £2,100 by 31 March 2027
- £2,800 by 30 April 2027

4.2 If you are not making reasonable progress towards these milestones and have not engaged with support offered by Transaid, Transaid reserves the right to withdraw your charity place and reallocate it to another applicant. If you have not raised £1,400 by 28 February 2027, we may reallocate your place.

4.3 Any decision regarding the withdrawal or reallocation of a charity place will be made at the discretion of Transaid.

#### **5. Donations and sponsorship**

5.1 Gift Aid does not count towards the £2,800 minimum fundraising target.

5.2 You must ensure that all sponsorship and donations are collected in accordance with UK fundraising regulations.

5.3 You agree to make it clear to supporters that donations are being made to Transaid and are generally non-refundable.

5.4 If you withdraw from the event, any sponsorship money already raised will remain a donation to Transaid unless Transaid is legally required to refund it.

5.5 All offline sponsorship monies must be paid to Transaid as soon as reasonably possible and no later than four weeks after the event.

#### **6. Fundraising conduct**

6.1 You agree to conduct all fundraising activities lawfully, responsibly and in a manner that reflects positively on Transaid.

6.2 You will obtain any licences, permissions or approvals required for fundraising activities, raffles, collections or events.

6.3 You will not undertake any activity that could damage the reputation of Transaid.

6.4 Transaid reserves the right to require you to cease any fundraising activity that it considers inappropriate or potentially harmful to the charity.

## **7. Health and safety**

7.1 Participation in the TCS London Marathon is entirely at your own risk.

7.2 You confirm that you are medically fit to participate and will seek appropriate medical advice if you have any concerns regarding your health or ability to take part.

7.3 You understand that Transaid is not the event organiser and cannot accept responsibility for injury, illness, loss or damage arising from your training for or participation in the event.

7.4 You agree to comply with all rules, regulations and instructions issued by London Marathon Events.

## **8. Withdrawal and deferral**

8.1 If circumstances arise that may prevent you from participating, you agree to inform Transaid as soon as possible.

8.2 Any request to defer your place to a future London Marathon event will be considered on a case-by-case basis and cannot be guaranteed.

8.3 If you withdraw from the event, you remain responsible for paying to Transaid any sponsorship monies already collected.

## **9. Photography and publicity**

9.1 You grant Transaid permission to use photographs, videos, quotes and other content relating to your participation for promotional, fundraising and communications purposes across print, digital and social media channels.

9.2 If you wish to withdraw this permission, you must notify Transaid in writing.

## **10. Data protection**

10.1 You understand that the personal information provided as part of your application and participation may be processed by Transaid for the administration of the event.

10.2 You consent to relevant participant information being shared with London Marathon Events where required for event administration.

10.3 Your information will be processed in accordance with Transaid's Privacy Policy.

## **11. General**

11.1 Transaid reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions where necessary.

11.2 Transaid reserves the right to withdraw a charity place if a participant breaches these Terms and Conditions or acts in a way that may bring the charity into disrepute.

11.3 All decisions made by Transaid regarding the allocation, withdrawal or management of charity places shall be final.
